Artist **Susan E. Roden** creates dramatic pastels with use of intriguing compositions, intense shadows and portrayed in simplified settings.

Roden has extensive experience and awards in national juried exhibitions, including the prestigious Catherine Lorillard Wolfe Art Club in New York City where she received the Medal of Honor and First Place in 1994 and the Merit Award in 2002 at the *Pastel Artist Journal's* Third Annual Pastel 100.

Her work has been featured on the cover of *Pastel Artist International Magazine* in 2002 with an extensive accompanying article on her unusual technique. Her paintings have been featured in *Decor and Style* and *Southwest Art's* August 2004 Best of the West and October 2005 Collector's Choice issues, where she was named as the "Collectors Choice for Pastels". Her art is widely collected with representation by national galleries.



Roden's work ranges from journeys into stunning landscapes and still lifes to portraits that rivet and fascinate the viewer with evolutionary technique and vision. She studied at the Cleveland Institute of Art and the Art Institute of Houston. Roden is a frequent exhibitor at Ray at Night, a collaborative monthly "happen-

ing" of visual and performing arts, and was chosen as judge for the upcoming annual show for the Pastel Society of San Diego.
