After a successful broadcast career in Los Angeles and New York, Bree continues to blaze trails as an activist for human rights.

2010 INDUCTEES

Justice Judith McConnell - Trailblazer

A pioneer for women lawyers in San Diego County and co-founder of the Lawyers Club bar association, Justice McConnell has promoted gender equity within the profession. Judge McConnell was one of the trailblazers who challenged "no women" policies in our city.

Dr. Vivian Reznik - Activist

Pediatric nephrologist Dr. Vivian Reznik has worked to make healthcare more accessible to San Diego's diverse populations especially in the San Diego community of City Heights. She has spent considerable energy and time support arts and culture in our city.

Anna Sandoval - Historian

As the first female tribal leader of the Kumeyaay Nation, Anna Sandoval's leadership has greatly benefited her people in the San Diego Community.

Dr. Gloria Harris - Empowerer

Co-author of the first book published on the subject of women's assertiveness, Dr. Gloria Harris has helped numerous women become more assertively confident through groundbreaking workshops and her expert witness testimony has aided victimized women receive compensation in sexual harassment court cases.

Laura Rodriguez (1910 - 1994) - Bridge Builder

Known as the "matriarch of Barrio Logan" Laura Rodriguez, being inducted posthumously, for helping create the Logan Heights Family Health Clinic, as well as, establish and preserve Chicano Park.
